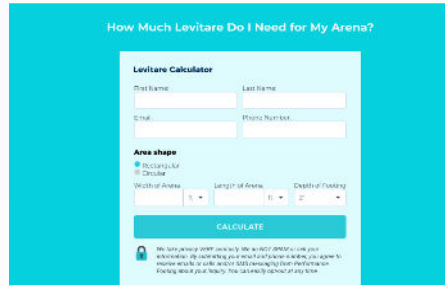
Simple to Install

Levitare is designed to be installed easily without the need for heavy equipment.



1. Prepare Your Base

Ensure the base is level, compacted, and well-draining. A base typically consists of a compacted subgrade followed by a layer of compacted aggregate, but the exact composition might vary based on regional materials and preferences. Learn more about creating a great arena base here.



2. Determine the Depth:

Decide on the desired depth of the Levitare footing. This will depend on the intended use of the arena and the specific properties of the footing. Using our footing calculator, you can get a suggested amount of Levitare bags to add to your current t(or new) footing.



3. Open and Spread Levitare:

Distribute the Levitare bags across the arena, as evenly as possible. The spacing will vary based on the amount purchased. Cut open the bags and rake out the Levitare using a hand rake or by hand.



4. Mix with Your Footing

Using a harrow, hand rake, drag or groomer, set the depth to your current footing depth and drag the Levitare in with your current sand or footing material.



5. Watering and Maintenance:

Even if Levitare reduces the need for watering, initially watering can help settle the material. Regular grooming using appropriate arena drags or rakes will help maintain an even surface and prolong the life of the footing.



6. Monitor Performance:

Observe how the surface behaves under regular use. Depending on the performance, you might need to add more Levitare or mix in additional sand. Additionally, you can add other footing additives like Noviun or Foam Footing or dust reduction material like Dust Halt to further enhance your riding surface.
